**Potable water is available on the grounds.**

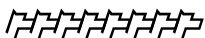

# Directions & Parking

The Brooklyn Fairgrounds are located at 15 Fairgrounds Rd., just off Rt. 169 in Brooklyn, CT. It is approximately 1.5 hrs. from Boston, 50 mins. from Hartford, 45 mins. from Providence and 45 mins. from New London.

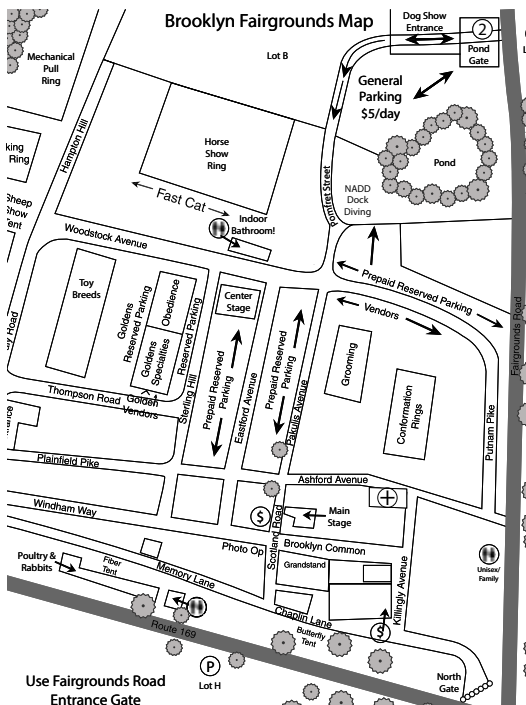
All Exhibitors and Spectators must use the Pond entrance on Fairgrounds Rd.

**From the North (Boston, MA):** Follow the Mass Pike (I-90) West to Exit 10 (intersection with I-290/I-395). Travel South on I-395 into Connecticut. Continue South on I-395 for approximately 16 miles. Take Exit 37B onto Rt. 6 West. Travel West on Rt. 6 for approximately 4 miles to the intersection of Rt. 169 in Brooklyn. Turn left onto Rt. 169 South. The Brooklyn Fairgrounds is ½ mile ahead.

**From the West (Hartford, CT):** Travel East on I-84 to I-384. I-384 becomes Rt. 6 in Bolton. Travel East on Rt. 6 for roughly 40 mins. until reaching the intersection of Rt. 169 in Brooklyn. Turn right onto Rt. 169 South. The Brooklyn Fairgrounds is ½ mile ahead.

**From the East (Providence, RI):** Travel West on Rt. 6 into Connecticut. Continue West on Rt. 6 for approximately 7 miles to the intersection of Rt. 169. Turn left onto Rt. 169 South. The Brooklyn Fairgrounds is ½ mile ahead.

**From the South (Norwich/New London, CT):** Travel North on I-395 to Exit 37. Take Exit 37 onto Rt. 6 West. Travel West on Rt. 6 for approximately 4 miles to the intersection of Rt. 169 in Brooklyn. Turn left onto Rt. 169 South. The Brooklyn Fairgrounds is 1/2 mile ahead.

#### **NOTICE – WAIVER OF RIGHTS**

All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the AKC, any AKC clubs holding cluster events, MB-F, all other contracted staff, Brooklyn Fairgrounds and its employees, and any workers and volunteers.

#### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- Fairgrounds will not be available until Thursday at 2:00 P.M. The Fairgrounds will close at 9:00 P.M. Every night except Sunday. On Sunday, the Fairgrounds will close one hour after the conclusion of BIS.
- Fairgrounds will open each morning of the shows at 6:00 A.M.
- No public seating will be available in any building. You are welcome to bring your own chair.
- All Grooming is to be at your vehicles. There is no Grooming in any of the Buildings.
- Ringside crating will be available in designated areas only. The area will be available 15 minutes before and after your breed is being judged. Please be mindful of other exhibitors and please adhere to the 15-minute rule.
- There will be no catalogs available at the rings. Please prepare the list of armband numbers that you need before you visit the steward. Catalogs may be purchased for individual use.
- No stand-alone fans are allowed in the buildings. Crate fans are allowed for dogs but must be attached to the crate.
- Please stack crates for small and medium sized dogs. You may be directed to do so by Site Control so please come prepared with boards and anything you may need to stack crates.
- Cooperation with all club members, Event Committee members, RV parking personnel and Brooklyn Fairgrounds is mandatory. Following instructions and directions is required at all times. Using rude, abusive, or foul language, or arguing or behaving objectionably against club officials, RV parking personnel or Brooklyn Fairgrounds will result in that attendee being immediately subject to a Event Committee Hearing and/or being removed from the grounds. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- No extended Flex Leads allowed.
- When possible please leave strollers outside. Do not bring them into any building.
- If you are leaving dogs overnight, each crate must have a name, address, and phone number for contact.
- No practicing in the rings at any time.
  - No vehicle containing dogs may be parked on the grounds overnight unless someone is present with the vehicle.

#### **Sunday, June 18th, 2023**

9:00 A.M. - 3:00 P.M.: Splashes #8, #9, #10 (First come-first serve.)

8:00 A.M. Hydrodash Splash #301

Splashes (\$28.00) include up to 4 minutes on the dock for 1 optional practice jump and 2 judged jumps.

The jump order is first-come/first-serve. When you are ready to jump, turn in your card to the judge (anytime up to 1 hour before splash end time) to hold your place in line.

Try-its will be allowed as space permits and during Splashes if no competitors are waiting to jump. Try-its cost \$10.00 and each dog will be given 3 minutes on the dock.



# AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers\*, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

*\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

## 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition

### Entry Fee: \$20.00 per puppy

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates.

#### **Section 1 - Classifications**

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
